Title: Ukraine – political, cultural and social approaches			
<p><b>Short description:</b></p> <p>This course aims to contribute to the study of Ukraine at a time when the country is facing aggression that threatens its sovereignty. Ukraine's rapprochement to the Western world represents an opportunity to reshape the political framework of the European Union, and it is therefore important to address the political, cultural and social dimensions of the country.</p> <p>To this end, the aim is to bring together experts from different areas in a cooperative effort with students from four universities, in a process that includes both a theoretical and a practical dimension with a view to a detailed characterization of the challenges currently facing Ukraine.</p> <p>The program is structured to take place in a hybrid way, with 5 days in person and 20 hours online.</p> <p>The program will include a maximum number of 30 students (20 international students from the partner universities and 10 Portuguese students).</p>
